

Five year average job placement rate within 12 months of graduation

Job Placement Rate - The number of graduates employed in the discipline (i.e., radiologic sciences, radiation therapy, magnetic resonance, or medical dosimetry) within twelve months of graduation, compared to the number of graduates actively seeking employment in the discipline.

The JRCERT has defined “not actively seeking employment” as:

- (1) Graduate fails to communicate regarding employment status after multiple attempts **OR**
- (2) Graduate is unwilling to seek employment that requires relocation **OR**
- (3) Graduate is unwilling to accept employment due to salary or hours **OR**
- (4) Graduate is on active military duty **OR**
- (5) Graduate is continuing education.
